1. How to Overcome Temptations & Addictions - John Kurian

Battle against temptations and addictions is one of the greatest battles a Christian is called to fight. This is a continuous battle to be fought till the end of our life.

The battle begins in out thought life and what goes on inside of us is of great concern to God. Taking our thoughts captive and making them obedient to God should be a vital practice in the life of every child of God.

The good news is that the Lord Jesus Christ is able and willing to deliver us from the clutches of our addictions and give us victory over temptations in our daily life. He is ready to help us by His Spirit to make us more than conquerors in all these things. He can lead us to a life controlled by the Holy Spirit of God bringing life and joy to our existence.

Let us come together to learn some of the practical steps we can take to overcome temptations and addictions and live victoriously.

2. Fear and Anxiety - Shanthi Davidar

Are failures and setbacks only in certain part of our lives like studies, career, etc. and are they confined only till a certain age? Can I always be a victor? When I am a Christian will I still fail? What are the effects of failure and setback in our lives? Is there a good future after a bad failure?...and many such question would be discussed in this session. So come prepared with your answers to these questions and your own questions to make this session a meaningful one.

Overcoming real life temptations - Money Overcoming Sufferings in Life Overcoming Obstacles to Missionary Life



Dr. Muralidar met the Lord in the year 1966 when he was a second year Medical Student at JIPMER, Pondicherry. He committed to set apart portion of his time in the service of the Lord Jesus Christ along with his medical profession. Following his MD Medicine studies at JIPMER, he worked in Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute of Medical Sciences and Technology at Trivandrum, Kerala. While he was about to join for DM Cardiology, he understood God's calling on his life and moved to Benziger Hospital at Kollam and was involved with the ministry along with medical work. In 1978 he joined Tribal Mission and has continued on. In 1990, he became the Director, Bethany Medical Centre, Anaikatty and has continued there for the last 35 years. It is a 60 bedded Secondary care hospital, and has a high school and a tribal hostel for last 25 yrs. He has been General Secretary of the Tribal Mission since1978 and President, Intercollegiate Prayer Fellowship since 1981

These many years of continuous preaching has taken him to the length and breadth of this country, meeting thousands of people, encouraging hundreds of believers to get involved in God's work, and sharing gospel to the elite as well as to the poor tribal people.

Mr. John Kurian is an itinerant Bible preacher & teacher. Born and brought up in a godly home, his father being a sound Bible Teacher and preacher, he came to know the Lord early, during school days. In addition to the training at home and in the local church, his involvement with operation mobilization and Evangelical Union (UESI)

helped his spiritual growth. Following his studies in English Language and Literature – he soon entered into secular jobs working in India and the Middle East for about 10 years in various capacities. All the while, involved in preaching and teaching the Word. It was while working with Prison Fellowship International as Executive Secretary (Asia Pacific Region), he was led of the Lord to resign to enter into a full time teaching and preaching ministry in 1985. Since then he has been travelling extensively within India and around the globe to fulfill his calling. God has opened doors for him to preach the gospel in crusades, teach the word in Christian conferences and seminars in many countries. The Lord has given him a special burden for the youth and families and he commits a considerable amount of time apart to minister in youth and family Conferences.

God has also been using him as part of the teaching ministry of Bible Colleges in India and the Christian Training Institutes in South Korea and Mongolia, to many around the globe through FEBA radio. He has published two of his books, one on 'Christian Family'(coauthored with two other Christian writers) and the second one 'Triumphant life' on victorious Christian living. The second book has come out in Malayalam, Telugu, Oriya, Korean, Nepali and Swahili (East Africa) languages. In addition to this, about 90 of his messages have come out as books in the Korean language.

He makes his home in Kottayam, Kerala, South India with his wife Betty. God has blessed them with 4 daughters and 8 grandchildren.

You can call him an entrepreneur, a craftsman, an artist, an agriculturist, a social worker, a businessman, or pastor; but Paul is more than any of these titles. Trained as a Physiotherapist he never dreamt of how God would turn his life around and give it a completely different purpose! 
Actively involved in developing the new subspecialty of cardio-obstetrics in India and created the center of excellence for Cardio vascular imaging at Madras Medical College,

JOHN SCUDDER ORATION



The John Scudder Oration was instituted in honor of Rev. Dr. John Scudder i, the first Medical missionary from USA who left the country of his birth to work as a missionary in India as both an ordained pastor and a medical doctor. The oration is delivered every year by an eminent medical missionary who has contributed to God's kingdom in India in the field of healthcare.

Rev. Dr. John Scudder I was born in Freehold, New Jersey, on September 3rd 1793. He graduated in theology from Princeton (1811) and in medicine from the College of Physicians in New York (1815). Right from his childhood, the spirit of benevolence and a selfless spirit were evident.

As a busy medical practitioner in New York, he was earning over \$2000/- per year which was a considerable sum at that time.

While visiting a Christian patient, he found a tract lying on the table with a call to go to missions. He borrowed it. Read and reread it. The message penetrated deep into his soul. His first response was that someone should respond and to the call. Almost in an unexpected lightening flash the call appeared to be directed at him. "Come over and help us."

When he shared this call with his wife Harriet, she unreservedly responded by saying, "Where thou goest, I will go." But his father, Joseph Scudder, a reputed lawyer, in his anger, disinherited him for venturing out on this "mad project". Despite this, on June 8, 1819, Dr. John Scudder, then 26 years old, boarded the ship Brig Indus along with his wife and daughter Maria from Boston's Fulton St. Dock to embark on a journey that would significantly alter the eternal destiny of many lives in this part of the world. The American Board of Commissioners for Foreign Mission was sending forth probably the world's first medical missionary.



The journey from Boston to Calcutta took four months. While in Calcutta, they met William Carey, considered as the Father of modern missions. Little Maria was stricken with dysentery and died. They then set out to Jaffna, Ceylon, where Dr. John Scudder established his first dispensary in Panditeripo. However, in Ceylon, their second daughter who was born died soon after birth.

Preaching was his first calling. Each morning, when patients gathered in his clinic, he always started by preaching the Gospel and then would provide his medicines. Distributing tracts both written by hand on 'olai' (palm leaf) or printed materials was the principal means of his ministry.

In 1836, he was transferred to Madras. Did Rev. Dr. John Scudder ever dream about a mission venture in Vellore? He beautifully described his experience standing on the top of Vellore's Fort Hill on September 25, 1824. "The view of the plain from this mountain is most charming. I had a most commanding sight of the whole city. It is very large. I also had an excellent view of the villages in the vicinity of Vellore. The tops of trees, which appeared at a distance; the paddy fields, in perfect green or yellow; the white bed of the river, which is nearly dry; the shades cast over a part of the plain by the passing cloud, while the full sunshine was on other parts of them; the fort, with its surrounding water and so forth, presented a scene which beggars all description. Vellore is not entirely surrounded by mountains, but you would be led to make such a supposition had you been where I was. Vellore is an excellent place for missionary labour. It needs a dozen of labourers ..." Probably it was this vision that gave rise to CMC and the college song, "Girded round by her strong ageless mountains...





A century later his granddaughter (Dr. Ida Scudder) went on to fulfil that dream. More importantly, over 40 of his descendants then went on to contribute over a thousand years (1074 years) in serving Christ in India.


Their significant contributions include CMC Vellore, Scudder Memorial Hospital at Ranipet, Voorhees College, Tindivanam High School, a vital role in the formation of the Church of South India, publishing scriptural literature in the local languages, translation of scriptures, Ladies Seminary at Chittoor, Palmaner lace making unit, and an elaborate organization of schools.


Even though Dr Scudder knew that death was advancing, he did not give up his work and continued with his usual zeal. He was in the field every day. He agreed therefore to other's suggestion to take a sea journey and stop his work for some time. He had made his wish known, "I wish to die in India. There I would be buried, side by side with my beloved wife." He believed that India was closer to heaven than America and did not want to make a second journey there. So, he went to Cape of Good Hope.


After preaching in the morning service and taking rest before preaching in the evening service he passed away into glory on January 13, 1855, at Wynburgh, South Africa. Those that stood around him could not but exclaim, "Servant of God, well done! The glorious warfare is past. The battle is fought, the race is run. And thou art crowned at last."
